Format and Rules of Play

1. 4 Person Modified Scramble using 2 Tee Shots Per Player
2. Two 4 Person Teams will Tee Off together on each Tee Box and Exchange Scorecards for Scoring
3. All players are provided with 2 Mulligans per Player
4. Automatic 2 Putt, Bogey is highest score
5. Separate Tee Boxes Assignment for Women, Seniors/Junior and Men
6. Tee Shots must be on the Putting Green for Closest to Pin Hole eligibility (Holes: 3, 6, 11, 17)
7. Tee Shots must be in Fairway for Longest Drive Hole eligibility (Holes: 2, 9, 12, 14)

Format and Rules of Play

1. 4 Person Modified Scramble using 2 Tee Shots Per Player

- Must use 2 Tee shots from each player
- Players tee off. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.
- Everyone get's relief - 1 club length
 - No nearer the hole and Cannot change Lies.
 - Examples;
 - If the ball you select is in the Rough - Everyone must play from the rough
 - If the ball you select is in the Bunker - Everyone must play from the Bunker
- Teams with only 3 players should rotate the 4th shot. No need for 2 tee shots for the missing player.

2. Two 4 Person Teams will Tee Off together on each Tee Box and Exchange Scorecards for Scoring

- When mulligans and tee shots are used, indicate (M) for mulligan and/or (T) for tee shot on scorecard next to the Hole and Players Name

3. Maximum 2 Mulligans per Player

- For those players who purchased Mulligans(green tickets), a maximum of 2 Mulligans can be used for 18 holes. Inform the apposing team how many mulligans you purchased.
- Mulligans CANNOT be used for tee shot on Par 3's (Hole 3, 6, 11, 17)
- Mulligans CANNOT be used for tee shot on Longest drive holes (Holes 2, 9, 12, 14)

Format and Rules of Play

4. Automatic 2-Putt Rule (Pick up if all first putts are missed)

- When you are on the green everyone on the team will have 1 Putt to hole out. If the first putt is missed, pick up and mark a two putt and move to the next hole..
 - Note: Putting from off the green does not count as a Putt

5. Tee box assignment for Women, Seniors/Juniors, and Men

- Women tee off from Red Tee
- Seniors (60+) and Juniors (17yrs and Under) tee off from White Tee
- Men (18yrs - 59yrs) tee off from Blue Tee

6. Tee Shots must be on the Putting Green for Closest to Pin Hole eligibility (Holes: 3, 6, 11, 17)

7. Tee Shots must be in Fairway for Longest Drive Hole eligibility (Holes: 2, 9, 12, 14)



Format and Rules of Play

- USGA Rules govern all play with the exception of the following Local Rules at The Preserve at Jordan Lake.
 - A mandatory drop must be taken when a ball comes to rest in any sod netting. A free drop is granted when a ball comes to rest in any sod seams
- In the event of a tie, the winning team will be determined by comparing scores beginning on the number 1 handicap hole until the tie is broken
- Any questions on the rules... play 2 balls and address after the round with the rules committee

- Hazard stake/line definitions
 - White = Out-of-bounds, stroke and distance penalty.
 - A golfer must assess himself a 1-stroke penalty and return to the spot of previous shot and hit it again.
 - Yellow = hazard. One stroke penalty.
 - A golfer must assess himself a 1-stroke penalty and either return to the spot from where previous stroke was played and hit it again or take a drop behind the point where the ball crossed the hazard line as far back as the golfer wishes in line with the flag.
 - Red = Lateral hazard
 - A golfer can play from the hazard but cannot ground the club prior to the down swing or take a 1-stroke penalty and drop within 2 club lengths where the ball crossed the hazard.



Prizes will be awarded for the following:

- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Low Gross
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Low Net
- Hole-in-One holes 3, 6, 11, 17
- Closest-to-Pin holes 3, 6, 11, 17
- Longest Drive holes
 - Men = holes 8, 12, 2
 - Women = hole 14



HANDICAP FORMULAS FOR LOW NET

➤How to calculate Team Handicap:

- Total Player points in the table 1 below equals the team score/team handicap in the table 2 to the right.
- Each team will get a team handicap that will be added or subtracted to the gross score for 18 Holes.

Example:
